

RESOLUTION 149

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF BROOKINGS, AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the Council of the City of Brookings, Oregon, having deemed it necessary and expedient, does hereby declare its intention and purpose to commence the following improvements:

Exhibit "A" attached hereto and by reference incorporated herein as though set forth in its entirety.

2. That the plans, specifications and estimate for said improvements required by the City Engineer by a motion of the Council on the 11th day of August, 1970, and submitted to the Council on the 18th day of August, 1970, hereby approved and adopted; and this Resolution, together with a copy of such plans, specifications and estimates, shall be filed with the Recorder, and shall be available for public inspection within the office of the Recorder.

3. That the Council hereby defines the boundaries of the assessment district to be benefited and assessed for said improvement as follows:

Exhibit "B" attached hereto and by reference incorporated herein as though set forth in its entirety.

4. That the Council hereby determines that the benefited property to be assessed within and said district is as follows:

Exhibit "C" attached hereto and by reference incorporated herein as though set forth in its entirety.

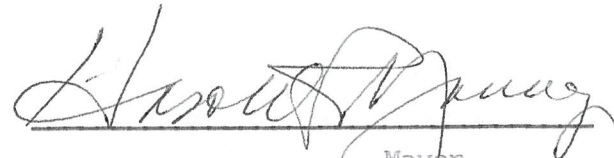
5. That the probable cost of said improvements as estimated by the City Engineer, (Exhibit "D"), will be \$22,233. That the property within said district to be benefited by said improvements shall be assessed by two methods: The proposed improvement shall be divided into two (2) parts; that of constructing the curbs and that of the remaining project, including excavation, base rock, paving, all drainage facilities, and all other services, equipment, and materials incidental to and necessary to complete the project. All properties fronting on the project will share the cost of the curb construction by the front foot method. All properties benefiting from the improvements will share the cost of the remaining project, as defined, on a cost per lot basis. That the City of Brookings may issue a promissory note, or notes, as a general obligation of said City for the interim financing of said improvements. That the City is authorized to pay for the cost of any part of the improvements which in the opinion of the Council warrants only a partial payment or no payment by the benefited property of the cost of such part of the improvement.

6. That the construction may be done in whole, or in part, by the City of Brookings, by a Contractor or by any other Governmental agency, or by any combination thereof.

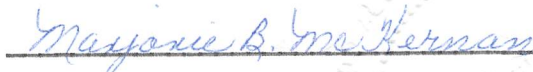
7. That a public hearing will be held before the Council at the Council Chambers of the City Hall in Brookings, Curry County, Oregon, at the hour of 8:00 o'clock P.M. on the 8th day of September, 1970, to hear and consider objections and remonstrances to the above proposed improvements.

8. That the Recorder shall give notice of such improvements by publication twice in the Brookings-Harbor Pilot, a newspaper of general circulation within the City of Brookings, the first publication to be more than ten (10) days prior to the date of the hearing, and by mailing copies of said notices by registered or certified mail to the Owners of the property to be assessed.
