

RESOLUTION No 147

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Governmental Research and Service, University of Oregon, in cooperation with elected officials, appointed officials and the Planning Commission of the city of Brookings, has prepared a preliminary, comprehensive plan for the city of Brookings containing a background planning study and over-all comprehensive plan containing economic, population, land use and other basic information, together with an intended guide for the future, orderly growth of the city and its land use, street network and community facilities, and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission of the city of Brookings has reviewed the preliminary, comprehensive plan and recommended its adoption to the City Council, and

WHEREAS, the City Council, having reviewed the preliminary, comprehensive plan in full and having determined the same to be in the best interests of the city of Brookings for use as a guide for future, orderly growth of the city,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the city of Brookings:

That the comprehensive city plan titled "Planning for Brookings," published April 1970 by the Bureau of Governmental Research and Service, University of Oregon, be and the same is hereby approved and adopted as the comprehensive city plan for the city of Brookings, Oregon.

That such plan shall be continually used by the elected and appointed officials of the city of Brookings as a guide in making decisions related to community development.
