

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF BROOKINGS AS FOLLOWS:


The Council of the City of Brookings, pursuant to authority granted to it under the provisions of Ordinance No. 157 of the City of Brookings, Section 3 thereof, does hereby establish the following traffic controls:

The time limit for legal parking in the following described parking areas is hereby established as one hour, to-wit:

1. Chetco Avenue, from Arnold Lane to Oak Street.
2. Center Street, from Chetco Avenue to Spruce Street.
3. Wharf Street, from Chetco Avenue to Spruce Street.
4. Spruce Street, from Center Street to Wharf Street.
5. Hillside Avenue, from Chetco Avenue to Valley.
6. Fern Street, from Chetco Avenue to Redwood Avenue.

The Police Department is hereby directed to install appropriate signs and markings to indicate the limited parking areas above described. These traffic controls shall become immediately effective upon the installation of such signs and markings.


