

RESOLUTION

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WHEREAS, the following facts are deemed to be existent and important to the future of the city of Brookings, to-wit:

ORS 190.010 authorizes local governments to make agreements for the joint performance, planning and administrative functions;

There is a need for such a planning agency within Coos and Curry Counties;

The county, cities and port districts of Coos and Curry Counties, Oregon desire to associate themselves together and form an organization known as the Coos-Curry Council of Governments;

The county, cities and port districts of Coos and Curry Counties, Oregon desire that membership be composed of general purpose and special purpose units of governments;

The underlying concept of the Coos-Curry Council of Governments is that the counties, cities and port districts, which are closest to the people, should exercise the basic initiative and leadership, and that they should have the primary responsibility for treating with those local problems and needs which require action on an areawide or regional basis, and when such terms are used herein shall refer only to areas within the exterior boundary of the counties of Coos and Curry;

Constructive and workable policies and programs for meeting areawide problems of local government will be most effectively and expeditiously developed by regular meetings of governmental unit members in an areawide voluntary and cooperative association dedicated to the solution of these problems;

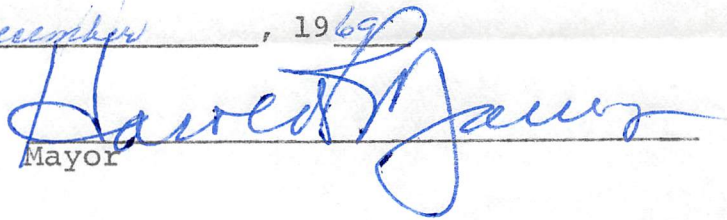
The Coos-Curry Council of Governments is based on the principle of equality of membership and nothing contained in

its bylaws shall authorize the Coos-Curry Council of Governments to intervene in matters which are essentially within the jurisdiction of any one (1) member without its consent; and

The Coos-Curry Council of Governments is not, nor is it intended to be a substitute for local government. It is, however, an organization through which individual governmental units can work on regional problems and coordinate their efforts.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF BROOKINGS that the city of Brookings shall become and be a member of the Coos-Curry Council of Governments and that the city of Brookings and its officials shall participate in and encourage such activities as will further the purposes of the Coos-Curry Council of Governments as above stated.
