

RESOLUTION No. 136

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF BROOKINGS, AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, it appears to the satisfaction of the Council of the City of Brookings, Oregon, that the hereinafter described assessments are delinquent, in accordance with the provisions of ORS 223.270, each of said assessments being more than one year delinquent;

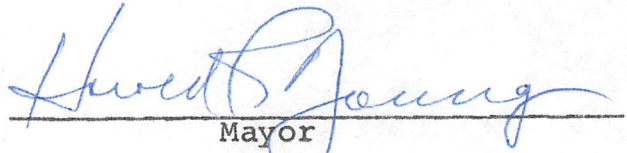

lien list and to deliver the same to the Treasurer of the City of Brookings.

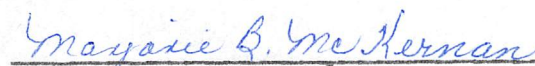
