

RESOLUTION NO. 126

WHEREAS, the City of Brookings has underway a project for the further improvement of the city sanitary sewer system and the resulting decrease in water pollution through the construction of the Memory Lane pump station, sewer lines and other facilities for the more efficient collection and disposal of sanitary sewage within the City of Brookings; and

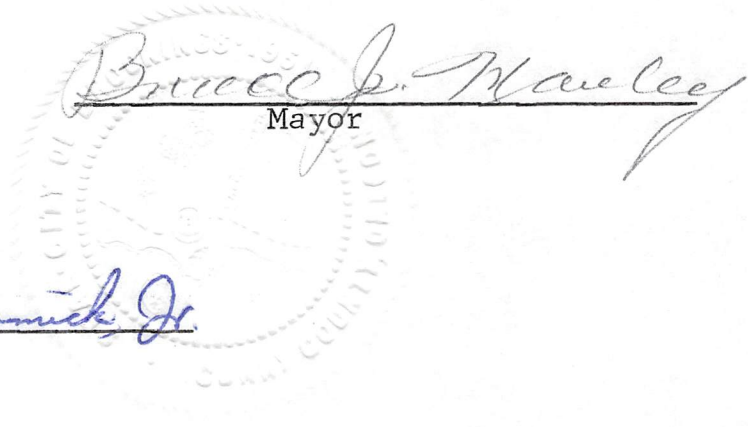
WHEREAS, the City is eligible for a Federal reimbursement grant under the provisions of the Clean Waters Restoration Act Amendments to Public Law 84-660, and desires to make application for such grant,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Brookings, Oregon, in regular session this 12th day of September, 1967, that the City of Brookings, Oregon, apply for a reimbursement grant in the amount of \$12,690.00 under the provisions of the Federal Water Pollution Control Act and that all necessary applications and formal requests be filed for such grant, and that any and all action heretofore taken or documents executed and filed in connection with the application for such grant in behalf of the City of Brookings are hereby ratified and confirmed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Recorder is hereby designated as the authorized representative of the City of Brookings in connection with this application for a grant of \$12,690.00 to assist in the construction of sewage treatment facilities in the City of Brookings, Oregon.
