

RESOLUTION NO. 118

WHEREAS, the Council has heretofore instructed the City Attorney to proceed with the collection of certain delinquent City Improvement Liens; and

WHEREAS, the City Attorney has reported that apparently the hereinafter mentioned liens cannot be collected without court proceeding and it is necessary that said liens be collected.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the City of Brookings in regular session this 12th day of April, 1966, that the City Attorney is hereby authorized and instructed to proceed with the foreclosure of the City Improvement Liens against the following properties and persons, or their successors:

1. Account No. 10-129, Dale L. Smith, Tax Lot 1200-41-13-6BA.
2. Account No. 10-122, Alvin and Joseph Sarver, Tax Lot 400-41-13-6BA.
3. Account No. 10-123, Lawrence George, Tax Lot 500-41-13-6BA.
4. Account No. 10-136NB, Fred Wertel, Tax Lot 2500-41-13-6BA.


All of the above tax lot numbers are in Code Area 17-11.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that foreclosure is authorized against the successors in interest of any of the above named property, owners and others holding any lien or interest in the property.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor is authorized to verify a forclosure complaint or complaints in the behalf of the City of Brookings, and the City of Brookings is authorized to take all action necessary to institute and complete said foreclosure.
