

RESOLUTION No: 103

WHEREAS, The City of Brookings has been negotiating for the last Thirteen (13) years trying to acquire a Municipal Water system for the City of Brookings, with no success; and
Whereas, The growth of this City demands a water system which will supply the city with an ample water supply; and
Whereas, The City Council of the City of Brookings feels that it is now necessary to establish a new municipal water system for the City of Brookings; and
Whereas, The Council believes that it is in the best interests of the people of Brookings that a new municipal water system be constructed to serve the people; and
Whereas, It is the opinion of the Council that the proposition of constructing a new municipal water system to serve Brookings be voted upon by the people of this city at a special election to be held in Brookings within ^{ONE HUNDRED TWENTY} ~~ninety (90)~~ (120) days after the adoption of this resolution by the Council of the City of Brookings; now therefore
BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BROOKINGS, OREGON, that the services of Cornell, Howland, Hayes and Merryfield, consulting engineers with offices at 1600 Western Avenue, Corvallis, Oregon, be retained immediately following the adoption of this Resolution, to prepare plans and costs of construction and furnish such other and further information, relative to the construction of a new municipal water supply system for the City of Brookings, as shall be necessary to inform the people of Brookings, prior to the date of said special election, of the costs and method of financing a new municipal water supply for Brookings.
