

RESOLUTION NO. 106

WHEREAS, the Council has heretofore instructed the City Attorney to proceed with efforts to collect delinquent City Improvement Liens; and,

WHEREAS, the City Attorney has reported previously that certain liens apparently could not be collected without court proceedings and has recommended he be authorized to proceed with court suit to foreclose such liens; and,

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the city that the following described liens be foreclosed.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Brookings in regular session this 8th. day of September, 1964, that the City Attorney be, and he hereby is, authorized and instructed to proceed with foreclosure of the City Improvement Liens more particularly described in the Exhibit attached hereto marked "Exhibit A" and hereby made a part of this Resolution as though set out at full and at length herein.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor be, and he hereby is, authorized to verify the foreclosure Complaint or Complaints in behalf of the City of Brookings and the City Attorney authorized to take all action necessary to institute and complete said foreclosures.
