

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, a major portion of the county tax base, and County population of Curry County resides within the Corporate limits of the Cities of Port Orford, Brookings, and Gold Beach; and

Whereas, said cities are charged with the construction and maintenance of a substantial portion of the total street and road mileage within Curry County; and

WHEREAS, each taxpayer is intitled to and should receive his proportional share of benefits from County expenditures; and

WHEREAS, streets within the corporate limits of the incorporated cities of Curry County are heavily traveled by all of the residents of the County, and are of benefit to all of said residents; and

WHEREAS, the residents of said Cities should in equity and justice share equally with other residents of Curry County in receiving road and street benefits;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BROOKINGS, OREGON, that hereafter the road funds of Curry County be apportioned between streets and road in Curry County both inside and outside of the incorporated cities on a fair and equitable basis, and further that not less than \$150,000.00 of said funds be apportioned to city streets during fiscal 1962-63, and thereafter.
