

RESOLUTION NO. 88

WHEREAS, the existing water supply for the City of Brookings and its inhabitants is not adequate or satisfactory in quality or quantity for the personal, industrial and commercial needs of the City of Brookings and its inhabitants; and

WHEREAS, no adequate provision has been made to supply a pure and adequate supply of water for the reasonably to be anticipated future population of the City of Brookings; and


WHEREAS, it is necessary and desirable that the City of Brookings take necessary and immediate action to supply such water system for the City of Brookings and its inhabitants, if at all possible,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Brookings, Oregon, in special session this 28th day of November, 1962, that the City of Brookings immediately initiate a program to supply an adequate and pure water supply for the City of Brookings and its inhabitants through a municipally owned water system.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City of Brookings, as a part of the project for supplying the City of Brookings and its inhabitants with a municipally owned water system, acquire by condemnation, the existing water system and facilities of the Brookings Water Company.
