RESOLUTION NO. 58

WHEREAS, during certain periods of the year the inhabitants of the City of Brookings are annoyed by stray dogs and numerous complaints have been received; and

WHEREAS, the Council is desirous of obtaining some expression of opinion from the voters as to the means of controlling this problem,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Brookings that an advisory ballot be taken in connection with the special city election on June ²¹14, 1960 to obtain an expression of opinion on the question from the voters.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the form of advisory ballot to be submitted to the voters shall be and the same hereby is adopted in the following form:

ADVISORY BALLOT

Shall all dogs in the City of Brookings be restrained on a leash except when confined on the owner's property?

59 YES

60 NO

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Recorder shall make arrangements for including the above advisory ballot on the official ballot for said special city election on June ²¹14, 1960.
