

RESOLUTION NO. 44

WHEREAS, the City of Brookings, Oregon, is engaged in the improvement of the existing sanitary conditions within the City by carrying forward a project which, when completed, will provide a new primary sewage treatment plant, pumping station and intercepting sewers; and

WHEREAS, the City of Brookings, Oregon, has been offered a Federal grant of \$45,665.00 under Project No. WPC-ORE-29 "Pick-Up", and it is to the advantage of the City of Brookings and its inhabitants to accept said offer,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Brookings, Oregon, that the offer dated June 10, 1959 through the Public Health Service of the United States of America to the City of Brookings for a Federal grant in the amount of \$45,665.00 to assist in the construction of a new primary sewage treatment plant, pumping station and intercepting sewers for the City of Brookings be and the same hereby is accepted in said sum of \$45,665.00, and such lesser amount as might hereafter be approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor, C. F. Campbell, be and he hereby is authorized and directed to execute such acceptance in behalf of the City of Brookings and the City Recorder, Bernice M. Huddleston, is directed to prepare certified copies of this acceptance.
