

RESOLUTION NO. 38

WHEREAS, IT APPEARS PROBABLE THAT THE CITY OF BROOKINGS WILL RECEIVE FINANCIAL AID FROM THE STATE OF OREGON FOR PAVING A PORTION OF THE CITY STREETS; AND

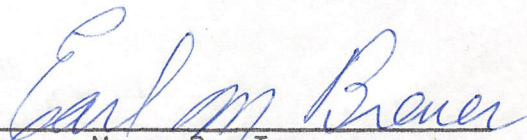
WHEREAS, IT IS NECESSARY THAT THE CITY OF BROOKINGS INDICATE ITS WILLINGNESS TO PAY THE COSTS IN EXCESS OF A CERTAIN AMOUNT,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BROOKINGS MEETING IN REGULAR SESSION ON AUGUST 12, 1958, THAT IN THE EVENT AN AGREEMENT BE REACHED WITH THE STATE OF OREGON FOR IT TO PAY THE COSTS OF PAVING PACIFIC FROM FERN AVENUE TO AZALEA PARK ROAD AND PACIFIC AVENUE INTERSECTION, BEING A DISTANCE OF APPROXIMATELY 1320 FEET, WITH THE PAVING TO BE 42 FEET IN WIDTH, THAT THE CITY OF BROOKINGS WILL PAY ALL THE COSTS OF SUCH PAVING IN EXCESS OF \$20,000.00 UPON THE PAVING BEING MADE UPON SPECIFICATIONS SATISFACTORY TO THE CITY OF BROOKINGS.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT THE MAYOR AND CITY RECORDER BE AND THEY HEREBY ARE AUTHORIZED TO EXECUTE IN BEHALF OF THE CITY OF BROOKINGS SUCH AGREEMENTS AS MAY BE NECESSARY TO CARRY OUT THIS PAVING PROJECT.
