

RESOLUTION NO. 19.

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF BROOKINGS, OREGON:

Whereas, pursuant to Resolution No. 12 adopted by this Council on March 13th, 1956, the City Engineer has filed with the City Recorder his report as the same has been required to be submitted to the Council by virtue of said resolution No. 13, and

Whereas, the City Recorder has prepared her notice, as the same is required by such officer to be prepared in Ordinance No. 48, Section 3, this said notice in form and context being as follows:

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN:

That the report of the City Engineer, as provided and required to be submitted in Resolution No. 12 adopted March 13th, 1956, covering and establishing a Special Assessment District within the corporate limits of Brookings, Oregon, known as Pioneer - Pacific - Easy Streets, Street Improvement has been filed in the office of the Recorder as of June 11th, 1956, and is available for examination in said recorder's office. The estimated probable cost of such proposed improvements is \$9,475.00.

A brief statement of the area proposed to be assessed for such improvement is as follows, to-wit:

A TRACT OF LAND IN SECTIONS 5, Township 41-S, Range 13 West,
W.M., LOCATED WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF BROOKINGS, OREGON.

CURRY COUNTY AND MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

PIONEER ROAD:

~~From~~ From the intersection of the center line of Pioneer Road and the
Northerly line of Pacific Avenue;

Thence following the center line of Pioneer Road, North, 663.0 feet to
its intersection with the North line (extended) of Easy Street.

EAST STREET:

From the intersection of the center line of Easy Street and the West line
of Pioneer;

Thence following the center line of Easy Street, West, ^{330'} ~~998.0~~ feet to its
~~intersection with the East line of Seventh Street (extended).~~

All persons interested in the hereinabove set forth and mentioned Special Assessment District are hereby notified to appear before the Council of the City of Brookings, at the hour of 8:00 o'clock P.M., on June 26th, 1956 in the City Hall of said City, and present their objections, if they have any, to the aforesaid improvement.

BE IT RESOLVED that the aforesaid notice of the Recorder be, and the same hereby is, in its form and context, authorized, approved and adopted as the official notice to be published and that the same shall be published in the Brookings Harbor Pilot, a newspaper of general circulation published weekly in the City of Brookings, Oregon, and having the qualifications by law required, in two consecutive issues of said newspaper, the date of the first publication to be June 14th, 1956 and the date of the second publication to be June 21st, 1956, and further, that the City Recorder shall cause a copy of said notice, to be placed in the United States Postoffice located in Brookings, Oregon, addressed to the owner or recorded owner, or owners, of the property located within the confines and area of the said special assessment district, as each and all thereof are set forth and mentioned in the aforesaid report of the City Engineer on file in the office of the said Recorder pertaining to the aforesaid improvement.
