

RESOLUTION NO: 22

WHEREAS U. S. Highway 101, a portion of the Oregon Coast Highway and a street of the City of Brookings known as Chetco Avenue, is presently in need of improvement to accomodate the heavy traffic thereon, and

WHEREAS it is the opinion of the Council that this said street may best be improved by the resurfacing thereof between Pacific Avenue and Oak Street, and,

WHEREAS the State of Oregon, by and through it State Highway Commission, has commenced the improvement of the said street between Harris State Park and said Pacific Avenue, and

Whereas, it is the opinion of the Council that it is in the best interests and economy of the State of Oregon and the City of Brookings that the portion of said Chetco Avenue, extending from said Pacific Avenue to Oak Street, be resurfaced immediately following the completion, by the State of Oregon, of its construction work upon that section of said Chetco Avenue extending from ^Harris State Park to said Pacific Avenue , Now Therefore: BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Brookings, Oregon, that the State of Oregon, by and through its State Highway Commission, be, and hereby is, requested to resurface U.S.Highway 101, a part of the Oregon Coast Highway and a city street known as Chetco Avenue, at some time during, or immediately following the completion thereof, its construction of the improvement to be made to said highway and street between Harris State Park and Pacific Avenue, and

That a copy of this Resolution, subscribed by the Mayor and City Recorder, be forwarded to the State Highway Commission at Salem, Oregon.
