RESOLUTION NO. 27

WHEREAS, the City of Brookings has for some time contemplated the purchase of a privately constructed sewer system installed in a portion of the City of Brookings in order to incorporate the same in the City's sanitary sewer system; and

WHEREAS, certain conflicts and disputes have arisen over the ownership of said private sewer lines which resulted, among other things, in the filing of a suit in the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Curry County to enjoin the purchase of said sewer line by the City; and

WHEREAS, the various parties involved in said controversy have agreed upon the settlement thereof and the proposed execution of a written agreement to settle the question and to eliminate the major obstacles of the purchase of the private sewer line by the City and it is desired that the City of Brookings join in the execution of said agreement,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Brookings, Oregon, that the execution of the proposed agreement dated December 18, 1956, between Elmer Bankus and certain other parties denominated "Taxpayers" and the City of Brookings would be to the benefit of the City of Brookings and the Mayor and City Recorder be and they hereby are authorized and directed to execute said agreement in behalf of the City of Brookings.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Recorder be and she hereby is authorized and directed to affix the city seal to said instrument upon its execution by the Mayor and City Recorder.
