

RESOLUTION NO. 12

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BROOKINGS,
OREGON

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Brookings, Oregon deems it expedient to construct, alter, improve and repair a sanitary sewer system and grade, base and pave certain streets and construct concrete curbs and drainage along and upon the said streets, all within the corporate limits of the said City, and

WHEREAS the said Council anticipates special assessments to be levied to pay the cost thereof,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED:

That the Council of the City of Brookings, Oregon shall and hereby does declare its intention to initiate the construction, alteration, improvement and repair of a sanitary sewer system and drainage, and the basing and paving of certain streets within the corporate limits of said City, in accordance with certain plans and specifications thereof now on file in the City Hall in the office of the Recorder and known and designated as a Special Assessment District and Public Improvement District, to be known as "Pacific-Pioneer-Easy Streets Special Assessment and Public Improvement District", and

That the City Engineer shall, and he is hereby directed to, make a survey and plat of the aforesaid Pacific-Pioneer-Easy Streets Special Assessment and Public Improvement District and submit his written report thereon and thereof to the Council on or before April 13, 1956, and

That the said City Engineer shall fully comply with all of the provisions set forth and contained in Ordinance No. 48, Section 1, of the City of Brookings as the same cover or apply to the aforesaid written report which the City Engineer is hereinabove required and directed to make.
