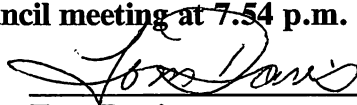
Councilor Hagbom asked when we are going to dispose of the skateboard park? Discussion followed regarding the deterioration and possible hazard liability to the City.
