**III. COUNCIL BUSINESS**

**1. Consideration of closure of city hall for one day per week**

**Councilor Hagbom expressed concern over the unused earned compensatory time off and suggested closing city hall to the public for one day per week. Those employees with accrued compensatory time would take that day off until the compensatory time is used up. Employees with no compensatory time off would work in the office, the only difference being the doors would not be unlocked and business would not be available to the public.**

Mayor Davis, Councilor Curry and Councilor Brendlinger expressed a desire to work something out without closing city hall.

Following discussion Councilor Brendlinger moved to direct the city manager to work up a schedule for the employees to use a significant amount of their comp time by the end of the fiscal year and to again review the employee manual prior to adoption to reflect the changes council has requested, which motion was seconded by Councilor Hagbom. The clerk called the roll with the following results:

Ayes: Councilors Brendlinger, Hagbom, Curry, Mayor Davis


Nays: None
