I. CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Davis called the meeting to order at 9:00 p.m.

II. ROLL CALL

III. COUNCIL BUSINESS

1. **Request for \$1,000 donation to Chetco Community Public Library District - Phyllis Cottingham**

It was council consensus that due to the budget shortfall, it would not be possible at this time to donate money to the library district. It was pointed out that the city had already given land and much more to the district.

Councilor Scott moved to decline the recommendation from Phyllis Cottingham that the city donate \$1,000 to the Chetco Community Public Library District for the construction fund, which motion was seconded by Councilor Curry. The clerk called the roll with the following results:

Ayes: Councilors Brendlinger, Curry, Hagbom, Scott, Mayor Davis

Nays: None

Motion carried; recommendation from Phyllis Cottingham that the city donate \$1,000 to the Chetco Community Public Library District for the construction fund, declined, with regret.

2. Solid Waste Long Haul Bids

Councilor Curry moved to recommend the bid from CTR using Douglas County Land Fill at Roseburg, Oregon for the first choice for solid waste disposal and transportation, with Riverbend Land Fill at McMinnville being the second choice, which motion was seconded by Councilor Scott. The clerk called the roll with the following results:

Ayes: Councilors Brendlinger, Curry, Hagbom, Scott, Mayor Davis

Nays: None

Motion carried; bid from CTR using Douglas County Land Fill at Roseburg, Oregon recommended for the first choice for solid waste disposal and transportation, with Riverbend Land Fill at McMinnville being the second choice.


XIII. ADJOURNMENT
