I. CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Hummel called the meeting to order at 7:02 p.m.

II. ROLL CALL

III. ORDINANCES

1. ORDINANCE NO. 91-0-477 - An ordinance providing for systems development charges in the City of Brookings, repealing Ordinance No. 87-0-418, and declaring an emergency.

By consensus it was decided to change the language in Sections 15 and 16 by renaming the present Systems Development Charge Review Committee to Systems Development Charge Review Board.

Two changes to Sections 3 were suggested by Councilor Brendlinger and, by consensus, were agreed to.

One change to Resolution No. 91-R-518 was suggested by Councilor Brendlinger which, by consensus, was agreed to.

Councilor Brendlinger moved to strike the emergency clause from Ordinance No. 91-0-477, which motion was seconded by Councilor Davis. The clerk called the roll with the following results:

Motion carried; Section 23 (emergency clause) stricken from proposed Ordinance No. 91-0-477.

Councilor Davis moved to adopt Ordinance No. 91-0-477, which motion was seconded by Councilor Brendlinger.

Speaking from the audience, John Zia, 97848 Titus Lane, Brookings, developer of an affordable housing subdivision (Cottage Court), requested that the council consider waiving some of the SDC charges for his subdivision. Mr. Zia was informed that the matter should be taken up at a regular council meeting with a formal request for consideration.
