XI. CITY MANAGER'S EMPLOYMENT AGREEMENT

Mayor Hummel announced that the issue before the Council is to decide whether to take action on the City Manager's employment agreement in light of the legal opinion received by the City from Michael Gillespie, an independent attorney who was hired to review the legality of the city manager's employment agreement. Mayor Hummel stated that Mr. Gillespie's opinion was that the employment agreement is void for a number of reasons, and the issue before the city council is to decide whether or not to dismiss the city manager without cause, effective on adjournment of this meeting, and that he shall receive compensation for hours worked and any vacation time accrued.

Councilor Schutt moved to dismiss the city manager without cause, effective on adjournment of this meeting, and pay him compensation for hours worked and any vacation time accrued, which motion was seconded by Councilor Brendlinger. The clerk called the roll with the following results:
