Subject: Smoking Ban in Public Parks

Recommended Motion:

Motion to adopt Ordinance 12-O-690, adding Section 12.25.017, Smoking prohibited in designated park areas, to Brookings Municipal Code Chapter 12.25, Public Parks and Recreational Areas.

Financial Impact:

There is minimal signage costs totaling \$400 for up to ten signs to be paid for from Parks and Recreation operating expenses. Public Works staff will install the signs.

Background/Discussion:

Council has considered this smoking ban proposal at a recent workshop and a City Council meeting on February 27, 2012. Council expressed concerns over the previous proposal's definition of restricted smoking areas, and the amount of the fine (\$750) being excessive. Staff has addressed the concerns of Council by reducing the amount of the fine to \$75 per citation and clarifying the language of where smoking is restricted to "within the fenced area of Kidtown at Azalea Park..." Ordinance 12-O-690 continues to place smoking restrictions in all children's playgrounds, athletic fields, bleachers, and within 20 feet of all restrooms and concessions facilities.

The Parks and Recreation Commission unanimously voted in favor of a smoking ban in select areas of all City Parks at its November 17, 2011 meeting.

<u>Subject</u>: Amendments to Brookings Municipal Code Chapter 2.50, Parks and Recreation Commission

Recommended Motion:

Adopt Ordinance 12-O-695, amending Brookings Municipal Code Section 2.50.010, Creation of parks and recreation commission.

Financial Impact:

Minimal cost of updating the Brookings Municipal Code

Background/Discussion:

At the February 27, 2012 City Council meeting, it was noted that City officials and employees are restricted, by ordinance, from being appointed to the Planning Commission and Urban Renewal Advisory Commission, but not the Parks and Recreation Commission. Adoption of the attached ordinance would provide consistency by incorporating this restriction into Brookings Municipal Code Chapter 2.50, Parks and Recreation Commission (amended language shown below, in bold):

2.50.010 Creation of parks and recreation commission.

There is hereby created a parks and recreation commission for the city of Brookings, Oregon, consisting of five members, as hereinafter provided. The five members of the commission shall be appointed by the mayor with the approval of the council. These members shall not be officials or employees of the city. Four of the five members shall be residents of Brookings, and one member may be a resident within the Brookings urban growth area. The city council may appoint one of its own members to act as liaison between the commission and the council. Membership shall be restricted pursuant to Chapter 2.01 BMC.
