Re: County's Juvenile Department

I've reviewed the relevant sections of BLDC looking for some ambiguous language in Sections 17.80 and 17.168 that we could interpret. Looking every which way, there does not seem to be any ambiguity in those sections of the code.

Here is a different idea to consider which would be within our legal framework, including the Final Order to the County, our BLCD and our ordinances. I reviewed it with City Manager and Finance Director.

Railroad Street improvements are available for funding from our Street SDC Fund, our Street System Replacement Fund and our Street Maintenance Fund. The balances in those funds are \$250,000, \$180,000 and \$93,000 respectively.

We might want to consider a partnership between the County and City (a public-public partnership) to share the costs equally for the required street improvements. There would be strict requirements in the deal such as engineered design, approved by our PW department and so forth.

This kind of partnership might raise the question: if we do it for the County, where do we draw the line?

The answer: we draw the line at: 1. public entities, 2. other funding sources unavailable, 3. profound community need unmet by the private sector, 4. funds available.

By a 4-0-2 (motion: Commissioner Markham) the Planning Commission approved the minutes of October 17, 2006. (Commissioners Dundom and Nishioka abstained as they were absent from the meeting)

THE PLANNING COMMISSION TOOK THE FOLLOWING ACTION ON WRITTEN REQUESTS AND COMMUNICATIONS

None.

THE PLANNING COMMISSION TOOK THE FOLLOWING ACTION IN THE PUBLIC HEARINGS

1. By a 6-0 vote (Motion: Commissioner Hedenskog) the Planning Commission approved the application for **PUD-1-04/MC-2-06**, a request for a minor change to PUD-1-04, *Pacific Terrace*, to change the emergency exit from Izaiha Drive to Pacific Terrace Drive, to obtain approval of the water tank as presently located by authorization for a variation from height and setback requirements; and plat a 175 foot spur road, named Sage Lane, for access to Tax Lots 1527 and 1528; located at Old County Road and Marina Heights; Assessor's Map 40-13-32CC, Tax Lots 1501, 1527, 1528 and 1535; Bruce Brothers, LLC, applicants. Condition # 42 was amended to "The City Engineer will do calculations to determine if the water tank was sized to serve parcels outside of the approved 29 lot Planned Unit Development (PUD). If the tank has more capacity than is needed to serve this approved PUD, a reimbursement formula will be determined and administered by the City to provide pay-back to the Applicant for future use of this portion of the tank."

2. By a 6-0 vote (Motion: Commissioner Markham) the Planning Commission approved the Final ORDER and Findings of Fact for File No. PUD-1-04/MC-2-06.

All commissioners with the exception of Commissioner Yock declared ex parte due to site visits. Commissioner Nishioka stated he had received a brief phone call from Mr. Wise and advised him to hire a land use attorney and work with the City. Nishioka stated he could hear the case without bias. There were no challenges from the audience as to the jurisdiction of the Commission to hear the request.

Planning Director Snow reviewed the staff report. Snow entered into the record the supplemental packet (**Exhibit B**) containing a letter from Pete Chasar dated November 1, 2006 and a letter from Harold and Sherry Gallaty dated November 5, 2006. Snow reviewed the proposed conditions of approval.


