# COOPERATIVE IMPROVEMENT AGREEMENT Chetco River Bridge Lighting City of Brookings/ Port of Brookings Harbor

THIS AGREEMENT is made and entered into by and between THE STATE OF OREGON, acting by and through its Department of Transportation, hereinafter referred to as "ODOT"; the **City of Brookings**, acting by and through it's City Council, hereinafter referred to as "City" and the **Port of Brookings Harbor**, acting by and through its Board of Commissioners, hereinafter referred to as "Agency".

#### RECITALS

- 1. Bridge No. 01143D, also known as the Chetco River Bridge, is located on Coast Highway No. 9 at mile point 357.98, and is a part of the state highway system under the jurisdiction and control of the Oregon Transportation Commission.
- 2. 2. By the authority granted in ORS 190.110, 366.770 and 366.775, ODOT may enter into cooperative agreements with the counties and cities or units of local government for the performance of work on certain types of improvement projects with the allocation of costs on terms and conditions mutually agreeable to the contracting parties.
- 3. By the authority granted in ORS 777.112, the Port of Brookings Harbor may enter into cooperative agreements with the counties, cities, or units of local government for the performance of work on certain types of improvements projects with the allocation of costs on terms and conditions mutually agreeable to the contracting parties.

NOW THEREFORE, the premises being in general as stated in the foregoing recitals, it is agreed by and between the parties hereto as follows:

#### TERMS OF AGREEMENT:

- 1. ODOT plans and proposes to install pedestrian lighting and ADA sidewalks on the Chetco River Bridge, hereinafter referred to as "Project". The location of the Project is approximately as shown on the sketch map attached hereto, marked Exhibit A, and by this reference made a part hereof.
- 2. Total Project cost is estimated at \$400,000 in federal funds. ODOT shall be responsible for any portion of the project not covered by federal funding.
- 3. This agreement shall become effective on the date all required signatures are obtained and shall remain in effect for the purpose of ongoing maintenance and electrical power responsibilities for the useful life of the facilities constructed as part of the Project. The Project shall be completed within four calendar years following the date of final execution of this agreement by both parties.

#### **ODOT OBLIGATIONS**

- 1. ODOT shall conduct the necessary engineering and design work required to produce final plans, specifications and cost estimates; obtain all required permits, arrange for all utility relocations or reconstruction if any; perform all construction engineering including all required materials testing and quality documentation; prepare all bid documents; advertise and award all contracts; provide Project management services and all other necessary functions for sole administration of the contract, for the Project.
- 2. The total estimated cost for the project is \$400,000. ODOT shall be responsible for any project overages.
- 3. ODOT shall be responsible for ongoing maintenance of the sidewalks and pedestrian lighting installed as part of the Project.
- 4. ODOT certifies, at the time this agreement is executed, that sufficient funds are available and authorized for expenditure to finance costs of this agreement within ODOT's current appropriation or limitation of current biennial budget.
- 5. ODOT's Project Liaison for this Project is Lee Sparks, 3500 Stewart Parkway, Roseburg, OR 97470, (541) 957-3538.

#### **CITY OBLIGATIONS**

- 1. Upon completion of the Project, electrical energy costs for the bridge pedestrian lighting shall be paid for by City and Agency. City and Agency agree that said payment shall be a 50% split between City and Agency.
- 2. City shall enter into and execute this agreement during a duly authorized session of its City Council.
- 3. City's Project Liaison for this agreement is Leroy Blodgett, City Manager, 898 Elk Drive, Brookings, OR 97415, (541) 469-2163.

#### **AGENCY OBLIGATIONS**

- 1. Upon completion of the Project, electrical energy costs for the bridge pedestrian lighting shall be paid for by Agency and City. Agency and City agree that said payment shall be a 50% split between Agency and City.
- 2. Agency shall enter into and execute this agreement during a duly authorized session of its Board of Commissioners.
- 3. Agency's Project Liaison for this agreement shall be Russ Crabtree, Executive Director, The Port of Brookings Harbor, Port of Brookings Harbor, P.O. Box 848 16408 Lower Harbor Road Brookings, Or 97415, 541-469-2218.

#### **GENERAL PROVISIONS**

- 1. ODOT, City and Agency agree that a mutual review of the construction plans shall be conducted prior to advertisement for construction bid proposals.
- 2. This agreement may be terminated by mutual written consent of all parties. ODOT may terminate this agreement effective upon delivery of written notice to City and Agency, or at such later date as may be established by ODOT, under any of the following conditions:
  - a. If City or Agency fails to provide services called for by this agreement within the time specified herein or any extension thereof.
  - b. If City or Agency fails to perform any of the other provisions of this agreement, or so fails to pursue the work as to endanger performance of this agreement in accordance with its terms, and after receipt of written notice from ODOT fails to correct such failures within 10 days or such longer period as ODOT may authorize.
  - c. If ODOT fails to receive funding, appropriations, limitations or other expenditure authority at levels sufficient to pay for the work provided in the agreement.
  - d. If federal or state laws, regulations or guidelines are modified or interpreted in such a way that either the work under this agreement is prohibited or if ODOT is prohibited from paying for such work from the planned funding source.

Any termination of this agreement shall not prejudice any rights or obligations accrued to the parties prior to termination.

- 3. If Agency or City fails to provide payment for electrical energy consumption, in accordance with the terms of this agreement, ODOT, at its option, may pay for electrical energy consumption and bill Agency or City, seek an injunction to enforce the duties and obligations of this agreement or take any other action allowed by law.
- 4. This agreement and attached exhibits constitute the entire agreement between the parties on the subject matter hereof. There are no understandings, agreements, or representations, oral or written, not specified herein regarding this agreement. No waiver, consent, modification or change of terms of this agreement shall bind any party unless in writing and signed by all parties and all necessary approvals have been obtained. Such waiver, consent, modification or change, if made, shall be effective only in the specific instance and for the specific purpose given. The failure of ODOT to enforce any provision of this agreement shall not constitute a waiver by ODOT of that or any other provision.
- IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties hereto have set their hands and affixed their seals as of the day and year hereinafter written.
- This Project was approved by the Oregon Transportation Commission on January 29, 2003, Key No. 13098.

Agreement No. 20452 Chetco River Bridge Lighting

The Oregon Transportation Commission on February 13, 2002, approved Delegation Order No. 2, which authorizes the Director to approve and execute agreements for day-to-day operations when the work is related to a project included in the Statewide Transportation Improvement Program or a line item in the biennial budget approved by the Commission.

On September 6, 2002, the Director of the Oregon Department of Transportation approved Subdelegation Order No. 2, in which the Director delegates authority to the Executive Deputy Director for Highways to approve and execute agreements over \$75,000 when the work is related to a project included in the Statewide Transportation Improvement Program.
