### D. <u>City Manager Announcements</u>

### 1. <u>South Coast Interagency Narcotics Team</u> <u>Agreement</u>

Mr. Rainey explained that this agreement concerns a program which has been set up in cooperation with several law enforcement agencies in southern Oregon for the purpose of suppression and prosecution of narcotics cases. Mr. Rainey requested that the Council authorize the Mayor and the Chief of Police to sign the Agreement on behalf of the City of Brookings.

Councilman Batty made a MOTION, seconded by Councilman Nidiffer, to authorize the Mayor and the Chief of Police to sign the South Coast Interagency Narcotics Team Agreement; MOTION carried unanimously.

### 2. <u>Urban Growth Area and Area of Mutual Interest</u> <u>Management Agreement</u>

Mr. Rainey indicated that there is no action necessary on this agenda item, but that it is a draft of a proposed Urban Growth Area and Area of Mutual Interest Management Agreement, presented to the Council for their review.

### 3. <u>Grant Application - Environmental Protection</u> <u>Agency</u>

Mr. Rainey indicated that this agenda item concerns the appliation to the Environmental Protection Agency for funds for the planning and design of the wastewater facilities. Mr. Rainey explained that there is no action necessary on this agenda item but that a Resolution follows in which staff is requesting that the City Manager be appointed as the agent for the city of Brookings in all matters pertaining to wastewater grants and upon such appointment from the EPA and all documents authorized to sign any pertaining to wastewater grant matters from the EPA.

### 4. Siskiyou National Forest Plan

Mr. Rainey advised the Council that he attended a meeting at the Brookings Inn conference center on December 10 regarding the proposed Siskiyou National Forest Plan. The meeting involved the proposed "Evergreen Alternative" approach to the plan. Mr. Rainey noted that Mr. James D. Petersen has been invited to speak on the "City Happenings" television show which will be aired on Wednesday, December 16 and on Sunday, December 20 on Channel 4, concerning the proposed plan.

After a brief discussion, the Council agreed that the "Evergreen Alternative" seems to be the best approach and Councilman Nidiffer made a MOTION, seconded by Councilman Batty, to direct staff to draft a letter of support for the "Evergreen Alternative"; MOTION carried unanimously.

### 5. U.S. Postal Service Building Update

Mr. Rainey read a portion of an article from the December 14, 1987, issue of the Oregonian newspaper regarding the cutbacks in the budget of the U.S. Postal Service. He indicated that this might well be the reason that negotiations have ceased by the USPS to ascertain property for a new post office site in Brookings.
