A. 1985-86 Budget Presentation

City Manager Lynn Stuart indicated that all adjustments have been completed as directed by the Budget Committee, and he outlined for the Council each of the changes.

Mr. Stuart explained the change in the numbers in the Louis Eldon Morgan Library Fund, due to the sale of the stock.

Mr. Stuart indicated that as presented to the Budget Committee at the time of budget approval, the budget is balanced and is within the 6% limitation.

Mr. Stuart noted for the record that a public hearing was held to consider Federal Revenue Sharing and no one was in attendance.

Mayor Kerr stated for the record that he had had several telephone calls from concerned citizens regarding the sale of the L.E. Morgan stock. People were concerned that the monies had been turned over to the library and would be spent rather than invested. Mayor Kerr advised the people that the monies had been invested in the State Investment Pool.

Vice Mayor Batty commented that he was satisfied with the budget as presented and made a MOTION to adopt the 1986-87 budget as presented. Councilman Geraghty seconded the MOTION; MOTION carried unanimously.
