## MINUTES BROOKINGS BUDGET PUBLIC HEARING CITY OF BROOKINGS MAY 29, 1979

The meeting was called to order at 8:00 p.m. by Mayor Elmer Hitchcock. Members present were: Councilmen: C. Dwight Allen, Darrell Allsup, Ray Lockman and Jack Lowrie.

Staff present were: City Manager Frank Freeman, Chief of Police Bob Babb and Recorder- Treasurer Marge McKernan.

This meeting was called for the purpose to consider uses of state and revenue sharing and to adopt the proposed budget for the fiscal year 1979- 1980.

Violet Cary, Chairman of Curry County Senior Centers, Inc., presented the Council with a proposal which ask for the amount of \$5,500.00 to buy equipment in order to advance the senior nutrition program in this area. She advised that they served citizens from the State Line to Cape Ferrello. She ask that some of the City's Revenue Sharing be used for these items. After some more discussion, MOTION was made by Councilman Allen, seconded by Councilman Allsup and carried that the Senior Citizens first go to the County to see if they can help and if the Cities Budget passes then come back to the Council with this request.

Ralph Renn suggested that the Revenue Sharing money be spent to upgrade the sewer system, for he has heard for the past five years what a bad situation the sewer system is in, and if the City doesn't do something about it we are going to be in trouble. Take the street money and repair streets with it.

MOTION was made by Councilman Lockman, seconded by Councilman Lowrie and carried unanimously that line item 3 on page no. 10 be lowered to \$4,000.00 and line item 4 be \$1,000.00 to give to the Chamber of Commerce if the Chamber of Commerce complies with the by-laws of the Brookings-Harbor Chamber of Commerce.

MOTION was made by Councilman Lockman, and seconded by Councilman Allen and carried unanimously that the budget with changes be approved and is to be presented to the vote of the people asking them to approve the amount of \$244,196.59 in the excess of the 6% limitation.

MOTION was made by Councilman Allsup, seconded by Councilman Allen and carried that pages no. i and ii. Organizational Units and Organizational Unit Functions be approved as presented.

MOTION was made by Councilman Allsup, seconded by Councilman Lowrie and carried that the meeting be adjourned. The meeting then adjourned at 8:40 p.m.
