1. RESOLUTION NO. 209 - TRANSFER OF MONIES - 1977-78 BUDGET

MOTION was made by Councilman Allsup, seconded by Councilman Leeds and carried unanimously that Resolution No. 209 be adopted.

2. ORDINANCE NO. 302 - AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING RATES TO BE CHARGED FOR WATER METERS

Ordinance No. 302 was read in full.

MOTION was made by Councilman Allsup and seconded by Councilman Lockman that Ordinance No. 302 be read the second time by title only.

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3. ORDINANCE NO. 303 - AN ORDINANCE SETTING STANDARDS OF INSTALLATION OF FIRE HYDRANTS

Ordinance no. 303 was read in full.

After some discussion it was recommended that this Ordinance be tabled and the Fire Chief and City Attorney revise said Ordinance.

4. LIQUOR RENEWAL APPLICATION FOR KEN'S TAVERN AND CHANGE OF OF OWNERSHIP-NEW OWNERS ELINA M. COY AND JUDITH A. ANDERSON

MOTION was made by Councilman Leeds, seconded by Councilman Lockman and carried unanimously this application be approved.

5. RECOMMENDATION FROM THE PARKS & RECREATION COMMISSION

They recommend to the Council that they sell three small parcels of park properties to the adjoining property owners, and that the proceeds be used for other needs of the Park Department. Two parcels are small triangle corners in Towhy Tract at Memory Lane and Tanbark. The third parcel in the Elizabeth Tract across Richard Street from the Richard Street Park.

City Attorney advised that a title research would have to be obtained in order to know how these parcels were dedicated to the City in the original plats.

Suzie James was instructed to obtain this information.

ADJOURNMENT


