7. REQUEST FOR ONE-WAY TRAFFIC BETWEEN HWY 101 AND SENIOR CITIZEN'S CENTER, LOCATED BEHIND SHELL SERVICE STATION

8. LOAN CONTRACT AND SECURITY AGREEMENT WITH CURRY COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

The County agreed to loan to the City of Brookings the amount of \$60,000.00 for the period of ten years. This money is to be used to complete the lines on the Hi Level Water Reservoir. After some discussion a MOTION was made by Councilman Allsup, seconded by Councilman Allen and carried unanimously that this contract and agreement be revised by the City Attorney and then brought back to the Council for approval.

9. ORDINANCE ON DRUG PARAPHERNALIA Was read in full

Much discussion was heard on this proposed Ordinance. Some were in favor and others against it. It was the consensus of most that if anthing can be done to curb the drug use in this area they were for it, and by passing an Ordinance or Resolution it would give the Police Officers more power to control it.

MOTION was made by Councilman Ross, seconded by Councilman Allsup and carried that this Resolution be tabled, and is to be revised by City Attorney and returned to the Council.

10. RESOLUTION NO. 213 - ESTABLISHING HEARING PROCEDURES
