

MINUTES
BROOKINGS COMMON COUNCIL
CITY OF BROOKINGS
JULY 8, 1975

The meeting was called to order at 8:05 p.m. by Mayor Robert L. Kerr. Members present were Councilmen William Guthrie, Jack Ross, and Darrell Allsup. Councilman Ellis Dowden was absent.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

MOTION was made by Councilman Guthrie, seconded by Councilman Ross and carried unanimously that minutes of June 10, 1975, be approved as posted.

MONTHLY REPORTS:

City Attorney - None.

City Engineer - Gary Dyer

EASY MANOR DRIVE SEWER IMPROVEMENT BIDS WERE AS FOLLOWS:

MOTION was made by Councilman Ross, seconded by Councilman Guthrie and carried unanimously that the bid of Dan D. Allsup Contractor, Inc., be accepted.

WHARF STREET STORM DRAIN PROJECT. Mr. Dyer reported this project was completed on June 20, 1975.

WATER STORAGE RESERVOIR & SITE PREPARATION. U. S. Tank Construction still has some painting to complete on the reservoir and Ferry Creek Rock & Concrete has some site work yet to complete.

TRANSMISSION LINE PROJECT. Transmission line is being installed by city crew in accordance with Curry County.

FILTRATION PLANT. The design on this project is yet to be completed.

BROOKINGS-HARBOR INTERCEPTOR PROJECT. Mr. Dyer reported he had contacted E.P.A. in regard to the forthcoming grant in order to proceed with this project, and was advised verbally it would be advisable to proceed with preparation for bid openings.

MOTION was made by Councilman Ross, seconded by Councilman Allsup and carried unanimously that the City Engineer be authorized to advertise for bids on the Brookings-Harbor Interceptor to be opened on August 12, 1975, and to be awarded when Harbor verify and approve their share of cost on this project.

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RESULTS OF SPECIAL ELECTION HELD JULY 7, 1975:

City Recorder reported the special election was as follows:

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MOTION was made by Councilman Guthrie, seconded by Councilman Ross and carried unanimously that the Recorder's report on election results of the Measure Providing for the Establishment of the Office of City Manager be accepted and entered on the rolls as Ordinance No. 260 as approved by the voters.

MOTION was made by Councilman Ross, seconded by Councilman Allsup and carried unanimously that the Recorder's report on election results of the Measure to Levy a Tax of \$9,000. in Excess of the 6% Limitation be accepted.

PUBLIC HEARING:

BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1975-76 - Mayor Kerr announced this is the time for the Public Hearing on the budget for City of Brookings for the fiscal year 1975-76 and asked the audience and Council if there was any discussion desired. No discussion followed.

LEGISLATIVE ACTION:

1. ORDINANCE NO. 261 - AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE BUDGET FOR THE CITY OF BROOKINGS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1975-76 was read in full.

MOTION was made by Councilman Ross, seconded by Councilman Guthrie that Ordinance No. 261 be read the second time by title only. Roll call was as follows:

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MOTION was made by Councilman Allsup and seconded by Councilman Ross that Ordinance No. 261 be adopted. Roll call was as follows:

Ordinance No. 261 was then declared adopted.

2. PETITION from property owners located on or near Marina Heights requesting City to put a dust supressant on Marina Heights Drive. This project has been completed.

3. AUTHORIZATION FROM DARRELL SALISBURY to purchase materials at his expense for water service to his trailer development on North Bank Chetco River.

MOTION was made by Councilman Guthrie, seconded by Councilman Allsup and carried unanimously this offer be accepted contingent upon labor expenses also to be included.

4. LETTER FROM HEALTH DIVISION in reference to supplying water service to three proposed housing developments near Arnold Lane and Mill Beach Road.

MOTION was made by Councilman Guthrie, seconded by Councilman Allsup and carried unanimously that this be tabled.

5. APPROVAL for write-off on sewer usage Account No. 1-388.

MOTION was made by Councilman Guthrie, seconded by Councilman Ross and carried unanimously that this be tabled.

6. PAYMENT OF VOUCHERS, June 1975

MOTION was made by Councilman Ross, seconded by Councilman Allsup and carried unanimously that vouchers for the month of June, in the amount of \$44,721.97, be paid.

OTHER MATTERS:

PROPOSAL FOR AUDIT REPORT BY TAD K. L. ENGMAN - Fiscal year 1974-75.

MOTION was made by Councilman Guthrie, seconded by Councilman Allsup

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and carried unanimously that the contract with Tad K. L. Engman, C.P.A., for the amount of \$2,950.00 be accepted.

FORMATION OF A CURRY COUNTY COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS. Curry County Commissioner Les Williams was in the audience and requested support from the City of Brookings to form this Curry County Council of Governments. Mr. Williams advised that Gold Beach and Port Orford were in favor.

MOTION was made by Councilman Ross, seconded by Councilman Guthrie and carried unanimously that City of Brookings is in favor of forming this Council of Governments and a letter so stating is to be forwarded to the Curry County Commissioners.

COUNCIL MEETINGS. The City Recorder was instructed to inform all City Employees that they are welcome to attend the Council meetings.

SEWER - NORTH BROOKINGS. Mr. R. Baker, D.E.Q., has inquired as to when the City will be setting up another meeting with property owners involved in forming a sewer district in North Brookings. Mayor Kerr suggested the month of September, 1975.

SEASCAPE COURT. Mr. & Mrs. E. F. Lecair advised that they now own 10 feet of Lowe Street and are willing to dedicate this 10 feet to the City of Brookings in exchange for name change to Seascape Court and storm drain repaired. Engineering Department was instructed to get a title report on this street. City Recorder was instructed to advise the Curry County Clerk that Lowe Street is now changed to Seascape Court.

AUTHORIZATION TO RETAIN INDEPENDENT SPECIAL COUNSEL. Councilman Ellis Dowden requested authorization to retain independent special counsel to re-examine the circumstances leading to the purchase of the Brookings Utility Company assets, and contracts of H.G.E., Inc. Councilman Dowden stated that he would not obligate the City at this point for any expense, but will attempt to work out some program that is within our budget and stipulate that any agreement must be approved by the Council.

MOTION was made by Councilman Guthrie, seconded by Councilman Allsup and carried unanimously that Councilman Dowden be given the above named authorization.

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SURPLUS EQUIPMENT.

MOTION was made by Councilman Allsup, seconded by Councilman Ross and carried unanimously that Sam Williams be given authorization to advertise for bids on surplus equipment now owned by the City.

ADJOURNMENT


