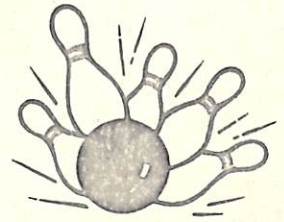

Gentleman,

As many of the members of the Brookings City Council already know, Azalea Bowling Lanes located at 410 Oak St. in Brookings, is in the process of making future expansion plans in this area. The area is specifically, the Woodland Highland Addition, tax lots 1 thru 4 and 15 thru 20. This is a one block area located directly behind the Beaver State Motel, one block off U.S. 101.

In making my plans I find that a dedicated 30 foot alley way, located in the center of the block is hampering my plans for full utilization of this area. The major problem I am experiencing is that it limits my off street parking area. My plans call for 26 cars in the off street parking lot. If the city dropped the alley way easement I could nearly double the off street parking near the new structure. Which would ease the load on city streets. With the alley way remaining, anymore off street parking would create a long walk for my customers.

I believe, you the members of our council will agree that one of our problems in Brookings is the proper use of off street parking. Therefore, I request the council to have a hearing to drop this dedicated alley way, on this property. My plans will be open for inspection by the council if they so desire, so they can have a full understanding of the problem.
