

MINUTES
SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING
BROOKINGS COMMON COUNCIL
JULY 31, 1972

The meeting was called to order at 8:05 p.m. by Mayor Les Williams. Members present were: Councilwoman Wilma Kemp and Councilmen Rush Long, William Higham, and Cal Gorte.

This special meeting was called for the purpose of making a decision on recommendation from the State Public Health Division. This request was that the City withhold issuing any building permits until the Brookings Utilities Co. provides water to City residents that is adequate, safe, and potable water supply for drinking, culinary, and household uses.

Mr. Fred Starkweather, attorney for Brookings Utilities Co., informed the Council that Mr. Bankus has agreed to comply with what the State requires. Mayor Williams also stated that Mr. Bankus had informed him also that they are ready to meet the requirements that have been set forth by the State Public Health Division. The Brookings Utilities Company had requested that the State Engineer come to Brookings and go over the present water system with Mr. Bankus and show him exactly what is to be done to meet the requirements. Mr. Bankus was informed that Mr. Cornelius C. Bateson, Administrator, would be in Brookings on August 21, 1972. The Council requested that they also meet with Mr. Bateson.


