

MINUTES
BROOKINGS COMMON COUNCIL
JUNE 18, 1970

A special council meeting of the Common Council was held in the Council Chambers of the City Hall on the above date. The meeting was called to order at 10:15 A.M. by Mayor Pro-tem Gilbert Batty. Members present were: Councilmen Bill Higham, Scott Sheppard and Alden Loring. This special meeting was called by Mayor Harold R. Young on June 16, 1970 at 11:00 A.M.

LEGISLATIVE ACTION

The Intergovernmental Cooperative Agreement by and between Curry County and the City of Brookings was read in full.

Part of the Agreement read as follows:

(1) County, in order to encourage and facilitate the development of an adequate water system to provide for the civil defense of the southern portion of Curry County, hereby grants to City the sum of Fifty Thousand Dollars, such sum shall forthwith be deposited by County with the Curry County Treasurer to the account and credit of City, City's right to the use of such funds shall however be conditioned upon its actual acquisition of the existing water system and facilities within its area (the term acquisition shall include purchase, contract of purchase or long term lease). In the event City shall not acquire the said water system prior to July 1, 1971, then on such date this Agreement shall be deemed null and void, and the granted funds provided hereby shall revert to County.


Councilman Loring raised the question regarding the date of July 1, 1971 as termination of the Agreement, his opinion being that it would force the City to buy the water system. Councilman Loring suggested that the termination date of the Agreement be July 1, 1972.

Councilman Sheppard expressed his opinion that, if the City shows progress toward the acquisition of the water system and if the project is not completed by July 1, 1971, Curry County will extend the Agreement.

MOTION was made by Councilman Sheppard that the Intergovernmental Cooperative Agreement between Curry County and City of Brookings be approved and Mayor Harold R. Young be given authorization to sign this Agreement. Motion was seconded by Councilman Higham. Motion carried unanimously.

ADJOURNMENT

MOTION was made by Councilman Sheppard and seconded by Councilman Higham that the meeting be adjourned. The meeting then adjourned at 10:30 A.M.
