

CITY OF BROOKINGS  
SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING  
JULY 22, 1969

The meeting was called to order at 8:00 P. M. by Mayor Harold R. Young.

Councilmen present were Gil Batty, Scott Sheppard and Alden Loring. Not in attendance was Bill Higham. City Engineer Ed Riley was present.

Reporters present were Dick Keusink, Marge Barrett and Ruth Brewer.

MOTION was made by Scott Sheppard and seconded by Gil Batty that Resolution No. 140, Transfer of Funds, be adopted. Motion carried unanimously.

MOTION was made by Alden Loring and seconded by Gil Batty that Resolution No. 141, Establishing Special Fund to be known as City-County Road Fund, be adopted. Motion carried unanimously.

Quotation was received from Coos Bay Stationery in reference to the SCM Photo Copy machine now owned by the City and 1 model 500 Copy Stat owned by Coos Bay Stationery. The SCM machine was purchased from Coos Bay Stationery in September, 1968 and has not functioned properly since. No action was taken on this quotation. Mayor and Council will check into it further.


Bud Cross, Chief of Police, had checked with the Retail Merchants in reference to time limit for parking control within the City, and reported his findings to the Council. After discussion among the Council and Citizens in the audience a MOTION was made by Scott Sheppard and seconded by Gil Batty that Resolution No. 137 be amended to read; 2 hour parking on all designated streets. Motion carried unanimously.

Jack Holte, Chairman of Planning Commission, was in the audience and he suggested off-street parking for employees. Mr. Holte will check into the possibility of obtaining vacant lots for this purpose.


