MOTION was made by Scott Sheppard and seconded by Alden Loring that the Council has approved of the Mayor's and Recorder's signature per approval of the Dawson Tract Rural Fire Protection District contract. Motion carried unanimously. L. C. McIntyre, President of Dawson Tract Rural Fire Protection District, was present at meeting.

Justice of the Peace Convention is scheduled for September 18-19, 1969 in Brookings. Judge Murry Palmer had ask permission to use the Council Chambers during the day time for this convention. Permission was granted.


