

CITY OF BROOKINGS
REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING
SEPTEMBER 9, 1969

Meeting was called to order at 8:00 o'clock P.M. by Mayor Harold R. Young.

Flag salute was led by Mayor Young.

Councilmen present included Scott Sheppard, Gil Batty, Alden Loring and Bill Higham.

Cameron C. Thom, City Attorney, and Ed Riley, City Engineer, were present.

Reporters present were Dick Keusink and Marge Barrett.

MOTION was made by Scott Sheppard and seconded by Gil Batty that the minutes of August 12 and 16, 1969 be approved as posted. Motion carried unanimously.

One bid was submitted for the new 1970 Police Car. Bid was from Richard Chevrolet-Buick-GMC, Inc.; sale price without trade-in of the present police car, \$2,800.00, and with trade-in, \$1,182.00.

MOTION was made by Alden Loring and seconded by Gil Batty that the bid submitted by Richard Chevrolet be accepted as per specifications of \$1,182.00 with trade-in. Motion carried unanimously.

Bud Cross, Chief of Police, requested Council to check into the possibility of having signal lights installed at Oak St. and Chetco Avenue and Center Street. Oregon State safety inspector will be in the Brookings area in the near future to meet with Elmer Lee and the above request will be discussed.

City has submitted a request to the State for ownership of a piece of property located on Railroad and Wharf Streets. As of this date there has been no reply to the decision.

Elmer Lee, Supt. of Public Works, reported that the Fern Avenue paving project is progressing very nicely. This project will be almost completed within one week.

Mildred M. Byrne appeared before the Council and requested that a building permit be issued for a residence to be built on her property located at the corner of Memory Lane and Del Norte. This property is now located in a C-1 zone. R-1 zone is required for a residence. Lloyd Mosier, who lives at the corner of Memory Lane, requested that his property in C-1 zone be changed to R-1 zone.

MOTION was made by Scott Sheppard that a public hearing be held at the continuation of this meeting to be held on September 16, 1969 for the purpose of considering proposed zone change from C-1 to R-1 of the Mildred Byrne and Lloyd Mosier properties. Motion seconded by Alden Loring. Motion carried unanimously.

Bill Higham, Councilman, reported to the Council that a verbal complaint had been brought to his attention; the dumping of rubbish on lot owned by Da-Tone Construction (Darrell Allsup) located on Memory Lane between Tanbark and Railroad Streets. City Recorder was instructed to write a letter to Da-Tone Construction asking them to remove the rubbish on this lot and to please refrain from dumping any more on this property.


The property behind the Bowling Alley on Spruce and Alder Streets will be cleaned up by the City crew.

MOTION was made by Gil Batty and seconded by Scott Sheppard that the vouchers in the amount of \$6,269.91 be paid. Motion carried unanimously.

MOTION was made by Gil Batty that this meeting be adjourned until September 16, 1969 at 8:00 o'clock P.M. for opening bids on Buena Vista Storm Sewer and proposed zone change request of properties owned by Mildred M. Byrne and Lloyd Mosier. Motion carried unanimously. Meeting was then adjourned at 9:15 o'clock P.M. to reconvene at 8:00 o'clock P.M. September 16, 1969.
