The meeting was called to order at 4:00 P. M. by Mayor Bruce J. Manley.


Councilmen present were Lloyd Mosier, Gilbert Batty, Henry Kerr, and Alden Loring.

Marge Barrett was the reporter present.


Bids for the Memory Lane Pump Station were opened and read. Associated Building Contractors of Beaverton submitted a total bid of \$34,916.50. Ausland Construction Co. of Grants Pass submitted a total bid of \$25,274.00. Horton Bros. of Brookings submitted a total bid of \$29,920.82. Fred Jensen of North Bend submitted a total bid of \$27,477.70. Rex Kimsey of Stayton submitted a total bid of \$41,599.00. The Council will take the bids under consideration and make the final award at their regular meeting on September 12.

Office furniture bids for the new City Hall were opened and read. Coos Bay Stationery of Coos Bay bid a total of \$2,585.34. Frank's Office Equipment of Coos Bay bid a total of \$2,828.70. Hale and Rudin of Portland bid a total of \$2,653.00. The Council indicated that they would take these bids under consideration, also, and make the final award at their regular September 12 meeting.

Following a brief discussion between the Council and Roy Erichsen, the meeting was adjourned at 4:40 P. M.
