by Mayor Bruce J. Manley


Councilmen present were Lloyd Mosier, Alden Loring,

No reporters attended the meeting.


Mayor Manley announced that water bond bids in the amount of \$350,000 which had been advertised for will be opened at this time. It was pointed out that no bids had been received. Henry Kerr then made a MOTION that the necessary papers for obtaining a loan in the amount of \$350,000 from the Farmers Home Administration be drawn up by the City Attorney for presentation at the November 21 Council meeting. Lloyd Mosier seconded the motion which met with unanimous approval.

The possibility of adding another 410 feet of sewer line onto the Memory Lane Pump Station project now under construction was brought up. Considerable discussion centered around this topic. Mayor Manley made a MOTION that bids be advertised for a 410 foot line extension onto the Memory Lane project now under construction to be opened on November 21. Alden Loring seconded the motion which was unanimously carried.

The meeting was then adjourned at 8:20 P. M.
