MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING CITY OF BROOKINGS JUNE 23, 1966

A special meeting of the City Council was called to order at 11:00 A. M. by Mayor Bruce J. Manley.

Councilmen present were Ben Franklin, Lloyd Mosier, Henry Kerr and Ernest Christensen.

Marge Barrett was the reporter present.

Mayor Manley announced he felt that the City of Brookings has done everthing possible to attempt to obtain a purchase price for the Brookings Water Co. The Mayor then presented a letter to the Council offering Elmer Bankus \$300,000 for the existing Brookings Water Company and giving him ten days in which to reply. A copy of the letter is attached hereto.

The Mayor stated he wished to have the letter adopted by the Council, and that he be authorized to mail the letter immediately. The Mayor then made a MOTION that the City of Brookings make a formal offer to purchase the existing Brookings Water Company from Elmer Bankus as set forth in the letter presented to the City Council, and that the said letter be sent certified mail, return receipt requested. Ben Franklin seconded this motion, and it met with unanimous approval.

The meeting was then adjourned at 11:05 A. M.
