## MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING CITY OF BROOKINGS NOVEMBER 21, 1966

The meeting was called to order at 7:30 P. M. by Mayor pro-tem Ernest Christensen.

Councilmen present were Henry Kerr and Lloyd Mosier.

Reporters present were Marge Barrett, Dick Keusink, and Ruth Brewer.

Judge Fell Campbell, representing the Curry County Court, appeared before the Council. He said that Councilmen Kerr and Mosier had conversed with the County Court regarding the possibility of obtaining \$30,000.00 to place in the bank as part of the Farmers Home Administration loan requirement. Judge Campbell pointed out that about the only way the money can be obtained at the present time is to borrow \$30,000 of the \$100,000 allocated for the new City Hall, and suggested that the Council call for a special meeting of the County budget committee with the request that \$50,000 be included in the 1967-68 budget as a water system grant. Henry Kerr made a MOTION that the City Council request from the Curry County Court a \$30,000 advance of the City Hall construction funds, said funds to apply towards complying with the Farmers Home Administration loan requirements. Lloyd Mosier seconded the motion, and it was passed unanimously. A meeting with the Curry County Budget Committee was then tentatively set for November 28 at 2:30 P. M.

The proposed City Hall was then discussed. It was pointed out that the \$100 a day penalty clause in the bid requirements should be dropped and that the kiln dried lumber requirement in the specifications should be changed. The Council requested that a special meeting be set with Roy Erichsen for November 22 at 8:00 P. M.

Following a MOTION by Lloyd Mosier and a second by Henry Kerr, the meeting was then adjourned at 8:05 P. M.
