

MINUTES OF THE CONTINUED COUNCIL MEETING
CITY OF BROOKINGS
DECEMBER 30, 1966

The continued meeting was called to order at 8:00 P. M. by Mayor Bruce J. Manley.

Councilmen present were Lloyd Mosier, Henry Kerr, Ernest Christensen and Ben Franklin.

Reporters present were Marge Barrett and Ruth Brewer.

Ordinance No. 190 was read to the Council in its entirety. A MOTION was made by Ernest Christensen that the rules be suspended and an emergency be declared and that Ordinance No. 190 be read the second time by title only. The motion was seconded by Lloyd Mosier and unanimously passed. The Ordinance was then read the second time by title only. Ernest Christensen then made a MOTION that Ordinance No. 190 be read the third time by title only and declaring an emergency be placed upon its final passage and that it be in full force and effect from and after its passage. Henry Kerr seconded the motion and it was unanimously carried. Following the reading of the Ordinance the third time by title only, the following roll call vote resulted:


