The continuation of the April 13, 1965 regular Council and the Special public hearing on the proposed zone changes was called to order at 8:00 P. M., Mayor Bruce Manley presiding.

Councilmen present: Henry Kerr, Ben Franklin, Jr., Ernest Christensen and Lloyd Mosier.

There were some 8 people in attendance to voice their opinions in the matter of the rezoning and ordinance changes.

Many views and discussions were had with the majority being that of pro.


After hearing these and all voices it was the decision of the Council to table the two proposed changes until the rezoning study, now in the process is completed and then go on their (the professional) recommendations.

On Planning Commission recommendation number 97, for the same action a MOTION was made by Ben Franklin, Jr. Motion 2nd by Ernest Christensen. Motion carried.
