MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING CITY OF BROOKINGS SEPTEMBER 21, 1965

A special meeting of the Brookings City Council was called to order by Mayor Bruce Manley at 8:00 P. M.

Council members present were Ernest Christensen, Lloyd Mosier, - Ben Franklin, Jr. and Henry Kerr.

Planning Commission Recommendation No. 105 was read to the Council. Following a motion by Ernest Christensen and a second by Lloyd Mosier the Council unanimously accepted the Recommendation.

Chief of Police Bud Cross presented specifications for the 1966 Police car to the Council. It was pointed out that the amount in the budget for the police car was \$2,800.00. Ernest Christensen made a MOTION that we accept the specifications and advertise for bids. This was seconded by Henry Kerr and unanimously approved.

The audit report for the fiscal year ended June 30, 1965 was given by City Auditor Bud Smith. The Auditor pointed out that should the forthcoming bondissue be passed by the Citizens of Brookings, the collateral security on deposit with the U. S. National Bank must be increased. It was also pointed out that money of the Municipal Court fines receivable are past due and may be uncollectible. Ernest Christensen requested a monthly report from the Recorder to show that fines which are levied by the Municipal Judge are being collected. Ben Franklin, Jr. made a MOTION that the City accept the Audit report. This was seconded by Henry Kerr and unanimously approved.

Beings, there were no other matters to appear before the Council, the meeting was adjourned at 9:10 P. M.
