

MINUTES OF SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING

CITY OF BROOKINGS, OREGON
 DECEMBER 23, 1965

Pursuant to notice and written consent to special meeting signed by the Mayor and all members of the City Council, a special meeting of the Council of the City of Brookings was held in the Council Chambers at 10:30 A. M. on December 23, 1965. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Bruce Manley.

Councilmen present were Ernest Christensen, Lloyd Mosier, Ben Franklin, Jr. and Henry Kerr.

The Reporter present was Marge Barrett.

It was announced that the special meeting was called for the purpose of conducting a canvass of the results of the special City election held December 22, 1965, in accordance with Section 28 of the Brookings City Charter.

Thereupon the Council canvassed the returns of the election, which canvass indicated the results of said special election by precincts as follows:

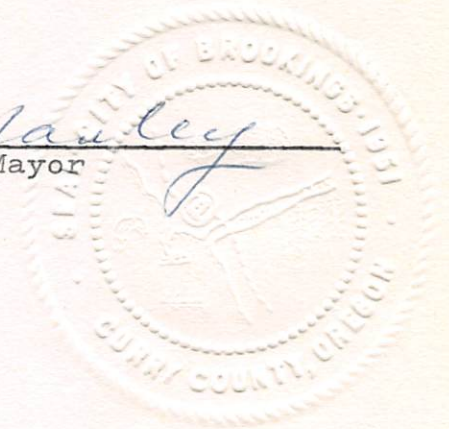

The Total number of votes cast in all of the precincts of the City of Brookings upon the Charter amendment in the election of December 22, 1965, was 549, of which 304 were YES and 245 were NO; that a majority of 59 of all ballots cast at said special election was in the affirmative and approved the adoption of said Charter amendment and issuance of the bonds.

Ernest Christensen made a MOTION that the results of the canvass be accepted. This was seconded by Ben Franklin, Jr. and unanimously passed.

The meeting was then adjourned at 10:45 A. M.
