CANVASS OF ELECTION

This is to certify that the undersigned, in accordance with the ordinances and the Charter of the City of Brookings, have canvassed the vote of a special city election of the City of Brookings held on October 14, 1964 on the Charter amendment submitted to a vote of the people by the Council and titled: " AN ACT To amend the Charter of the City of Brookings, Oregon, by adding thereto Chapter XII authorizing the issuance and sale of not to exceed \$1,300,000.00 in bonds of said City to provide funds with which to provide, buy, construct, equip and maintain a municipal water system for the City of Brookings and any combination of such purposes; providing for the payment of principal and interest of said bonds from taxes and water revenues; authorizing the City to secure Federal aid, loans or grants in connection therewith; providing debt limitations of the City Charter shall not apply to said bonds and providing for the operation, maintenance and management of such municipal water system."

We find the following votes to have been cast:

1. The total number of votes cast in Precinct No. 15 was 127, of which number 23 were YES and 104 were NO.

2. The total number of votes cast in Precinct No. 16 was 174, of which number 35 were YES and 139 were NO.

3. The total number of votes cast in Precinct No. 17 was 131, of which number 32 were YES and 99 were NO.

4. The total number of votes cast in Precinct No. 21 was 120, of which number 21 were YES and 99 were NO.

5. The total number of votes cast in all of the precincts of the City of Brookings upon the Charter amendment in the election of October 14, 1964 was 552, of which 111 were YES and 441 were NO; that a majority of 330 of all ballots cast at said special election was in the Negative and rejected ~~of~~ the adoption of said Charter amendment and issuance of the bonds.

WE, the undersigned, Mayor and City Recorder of the City of Brookings, Oregon, therefore find the said Charter amendment to have been rejected by the legal voters of the City of Brookings, Oregon, and the issuance of the bonds rejected.
