MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING, JANUARY 30, 1964


Meeting called to order at 2:00 p. M. at the Christensen building by Mayor Robert O. Dimmick. Other councilmen present were Henry Kerr and Ernest Christensen. Absent: LeRoy Weideman and Ben Franklin, Jr.

Reporters Present: Marge Barrett, Ruth Brewer and Dick Kuesink.

The Mayor stated that the purpose of the special meeting was to consider employing another patrolman for the police department. It was noted that Chief Cross will be unable to resume normal duty for some time due to an occupational injury and that unreasonably long hours of duty were required by the patrolmen in order to maintain adequate police protection for the city.

Motion by Ernest Christensen that the city employ another police patrolman, on a probationary basis, at the earliest opportunity at a salary of \$400.00 per month. Further, that a resolution be prepared prior to the close of the current fiscal year, which will effect required financial transfers for this purpose, in accordance with the ordinances of the City of Brookings and as required by the State Local Budget Laws. Motion seconded by Henry Kerr. Carried by all present.

Meeting adjourned at 2:50 P. M. by motion of Henry Kerr and second of Ernest Christensen.
