Meeting called to order at 8:05 P. M. Past Chairman, Leland P. Hein presiding. The first order of business was to elect a new Chairman and Secretary.




MOTION By Ben Franklin Jr., that Leland P. Hein be elected as Chairman of the budget committee for the period ending January 31, 1965. Seconded by Ernest Christensen. Carried by all present.

Motion by Leland P. Hein that James Yelton be elected as Secretary of the Budget committee for the period ending January 31, 1965. Seconded by Earl Breuer. Carried by all present.

The budget message and budget document was presented by Budget Officer, Don Page Smith. A comprehensive review of the documents followed and a number of the items of Requirements and Resources were explained in detail, with several recommendations made for subsequent study and decision. No action was taken to change the budget as proposed at this meeting, the committee to determine any necessary or recommended changes at a subsequent meeting, after allowing time for more comprehensive study. The second meeting of the committee was set for April 21, 1964 at 8:00 P. M.
