MEETING CALLED TO ORDER AT 8:15 P. M.; Mayor C. F. Campbell presiding: Councilmen Present: Ernie Christensen and Ben Franklin Jr.: Absent; Robert Dimmick and John Cox.

THE MAYOR EXPLAINED THAT THE STATE H. W. DEPT. HAD INFORMED THE RECORDER THAT BIDS HAD BEEN OPENED IN CONNECTION WITH THE CENTER STREET PROJECT. ONLY TWO BIDS WERE RECEIVED; THE LOWEST BEING SUBMITTED BY THE PELICAN BAY CONSTRUCTION CO. IN THE AMOUNT OF \$29,357.82. SAID BID BEING APPROXIMATELY \$5,400.00 MORE THAN WAS ORIGINALLY ESTIMATED. COUNCILMEN AGREED THAT THE CITY COULD NOT FINANCIALLY UNDERTAKE THE PROJECT AT THIS TIME IF BASED UPON THE BIDS THUS FAR RECEIVED BY THE H. W. DEPT.

Motion by Ben Franklin, Jr., that Mayor Campbell be authorized to contact State H. W. Dept. officials and explain that if the job cannot be performed for a cost more in line with the cities present financial capability the city will be forced to abandon the project, at least for the present. Motion seconded by Ernie Christensen. Motion carried by all present.
